







-Alphacoronavirus: HCoV-229E, HCoV-NL63; Pig, dog, and cat CoVs • Betacoronavirus: HCoV - OC43, HCoV - HKU1, HCoV-SARS, MERS-CoV, SARS CoV-2, rodent pig, bats and cattle CoVs • Gamma and Delta: Birds and mammals

• Covid-19 size:  $(100-160 \text{ nm}) = 0.1-0.16 \mu\text{M}$ 










#### Symptoms

- Symptoms that may appear 2-14 days after exposure to the virus:
  - Cough
  - Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Or at least two of the following:
  - Fever
  - Chills
  - Repeated shaking with chills
  - Muscle pain
  - Headache
  - Sore throat
  - New loss of taste or smell






### Proportion of Covid-19 cases, BCG vaccination coverage and affected population as of end of April 2020




Cases per million for representative countries revealed high cases in developed countries



#### Strain Phylogenetics








Phylogeny showed that clade A2a (indicated in freeform) was the most common in representative geographical locations
